## SAFETY RULES

Dear Exhibitor:

We appreciate your attending our Engine Show and hope it will be an enjoyable time.

Each member of Maine Antique Power Assn. is a duly authorized Safety Officer and therefore charged with ***enforcing and abiding*** by the rules listed below. Safety and safe operation of machinery are your responsibility. If there are additional concerns please bring it to the attention of our Officers or one of our Directors. We appreciate your co-operation.

1. Exhibitors running engines/equipment etc., must show proof of liability insurance. If you do not have proof of liability insurance, you will be required to join MAPA before you exhibit. Liability insurance is required by our Insurance company and is a benefit of membership.

2. Machinery that is running cannot be left unattended. This rule ***MUST*** be followed. If an engine is observed running and unattended, a club Safety Officer will shut it down and notify the owner. A 2<sup>nd</sup> offense will require the exhibitor to refrain from operation for the rest of the day.

3. Fire extinguishers should be where they can be easily seen and reached. The extinguisher should be large enough and rated to be effective on a gas or oil fire. (around 8 lb. with a rating of A-B-C).

4. Equipment operators are to be at least 14 years of age unless supervised by an adult. If the Safety Officer feels that a tractor operator is operating in an unsafe manner, that operator will be asked to cease operation for the show. Also, no more people on a tractor than it was designed for, that is -- one seat- one person.

5. No bare feet on the show grounds.

6. No open alcohol displayed on the grounds (per state law).

7. All animals shall be under physical control (leash, chain or in vehicle etc.). The State of Maine has a leash law. The owner is responsible for their clean-up.

8. Trash, please be sure all garbage and other waste is put into a plastic bag, tied and deposited into the barrels provided.

9. Generators are to run between the hours of 7 AM and 10 PM. Exceptions are some food concessions. Your cooperation is appreciated.
