I'll be brief. We plan at least a partial show season this year. Some non-MAPA events have been canceled but most are a go at this time. Cumberland Fair has announced fair date of Sept. 26 to Oct. 2 and Skowhegan Aug. 12-21. There may be new restrictions than in past years. We are recommending vaccinations & masks when closely interacting with other people as well as a current membership card at all shows. Most MAPA events are scheduled including annual Skowhegan show. The Maine Antique Tractor Club will be having a pull under the pavilion. We plan to have merchandise(we need donations, i.e., tools, hats, supplies, lady items, etc.) & a 50/50 raffles outside. We have not decided yet on the Visa Card Raffle. In case of rain, show will be postponed until the following day. Gas grill will be available but bring your own food.
